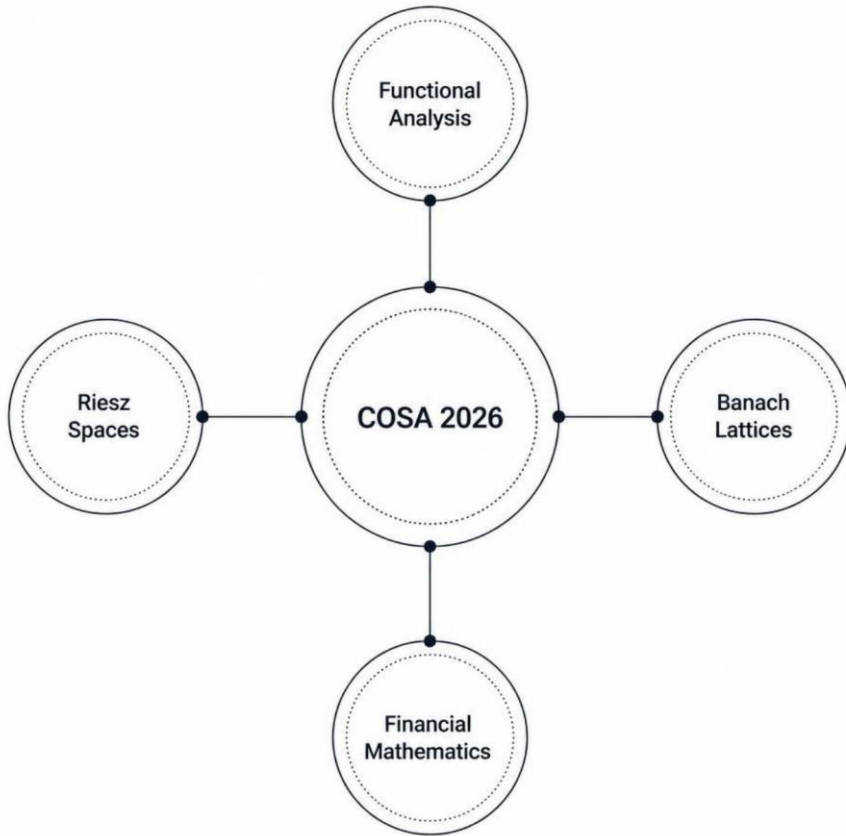
Bouillabaisse — Marseille's most iconic culinary creation, made with the freshest Mediterranean fish.
